

«Charity race «UNITED BY BRAVERY» (online)» Regulations

1. Race date

Date: November 27, 2022

Start and finish locations: online

2. Race objective

The charity race «UNITED BY BRAVERY | online» (hereinafter – the Race) is held to motivate amateur athletes to keep in shape, as well as to raise funds - 70% of the profit from the project will be donated to the UNITED 24 fund. The fundraising platform is collecting money for the "Shahed Hunter" anti-drone systems.

3. Organizers, patronage, and sponsors

The NGO “Run Ukraine” serves as the Race Organizer.

Under the patronage of

- The Department for the Youth and Sports of the Executive Body of the Kyiv City Council (KSCA).

The Race Organizer forms the Organizing Committee from among its staff and invites branch-specific experts from various types of sports.

The Organizing Committee includes

- Director of the Department for the Youth and Sports of the Executive Body of the Kyiv City Council (KSCA), Khan Yu.M.;

5. Terms of admission to the Race

The participants may be admitted to the Race provided the payment of the registration fee.

Please, notice!

- **A participant must be over the age of 18 to be admitted to the 21.0975 km course. The participant's age is determined according to the NGO “Run Ukraine” Race Rules.**

All registered participants bear sole responsibility for their health and well-being regarding the race and confirm it by signing a corresponding statement.

6. Routes and track

The participant chooses a route on his own.

The route (the final track of the run) on the 21 km course must cover a distance of at least 21 km 97.5 meters.

The route (the final track of the run) on the 10 km course must cover a distance of at least 10 km.

The route (the final track of the run) on the Free course has no requirements.

Runs of a smaller distance are not included in the ranking.

7. Race registration

Participants may be admitted to the Race provided proper and timely registration.

Registration only is possible online on the organizer's website <https://bravery.runukraine.org/>

Online registration of participants for the charity race «UNITED BY BRAVERY» (online with a medal) is open from November 10, 2022, until November 27, 2022, 22:00 (if there are slots available).

The Race Organizer reserves the right to suspend or close registration without warning upon reaching the limit of participants.

A participant is registered once the application is filled in and the registration fee is paid.

The registration fee paid by a participant is non-refundable under any circumstances, including but not limited to: if a participant is unable to participate in the Race, cannot finish the course of choice, cannot finish the course within the set time limit, or if the participant is disqualified or the Race is canceled due to the unexpected consequences of COVID-19 pandemic or force majeure circumstances.

A participant's registration is annulled if the participant provides the wrong information upon registration. If the registration is annulled, the registration fee is not refunded.

A paid registration may not be canceled, and the entry fee may not be refunded.

8. Entry fee for individual registrations. Slot limits

The entry fee for the course UNITED BY BRAVERY (online)(100 slots): 21 km is 450 UAH;

The entry fee for the course UNITED BY BRAVERY (online)(100 slots): 10 km is: 450 UAH;

The entry fee for the course UNITED BY BRAVERY (online)(100 slots): Free course is 450 UAH;

The entry fee for the course UNITED BY BRAVERY (online)(100 slots): 1+1 Team is: 900 UAH per team (450 UAH per participant).

The entry fee does not include the bank transfer fee.

9. Starter packs, starter pack distribution, medal presentation

The starter pack of a participant on the courses of 10 km, 21 km, and Free Course includes:

- participant's electronic race number with the participant's name;
- **participant's e-medal** (the medal is available in the participant's personal profile within 3 days from the date of the Race provided the participant finished the course on the day of the Race and provided a confirmation using Strava app (received automatically if the account is connected upon registration) or sent an email to registration@runukraine.org with a link or a screenshot of the finished distance);
- participant diploma in the personal profile;

10. Award ceremony

Winners are not determined. No award ceremony.
